

Home care after dental procedure.

\*\*Keep your pet in a quiet area until he/she is able to stand. Offer only a small amount of water initially (no guzzling!), and a small meal (about 1/3 the usual amount you feed.) By the next morning, most dogs and cats are ready for their usual food and water.

\*\*Add warm water to food 15 minutes prior to serving, or serve soft/canned food for up to one week as gums may be tender.

\*\* If sutures were placed in the mouth, they are absorbable and will dissolve naturally on their own.

\*\*Start any anti-inflammatory medication or antibiotic this evening, unless otherwise instructed.
